Commercial Data Collection Information

In May 2015, the Utah Broadband Outreach Center launched the locate.utah.gov site to display commercial level broadband services, along with other factors that would assist businesses in finding new locations and utilizing important business resources. The following information will provide basic details on how broadband data will be collected.

How can you provide fiber data for locate.utah.gov?

Providers can update data on locate.utah.gov on the fiber editing website located at fiberediting.mapserv.utah.gov/map.

- Create an account
- Indicate your service area on the map by:
 - clicking on a single hexagon
 - drawing a line (which will generate a series of covered hexagons)
 - drawing a shape (all hexagons within the shape boundary will be highlighted)
- Indicate the expected time frame to provide service
 -  Short Term - service can be provided within an average time frame of one to three months
 -  Custom - service can be provided within an average time frame of three to nine months



How will the project team know that my data is ready to be loaded to locate.utah.gov?

How often will broadband data be loaded to locate.utah.gov?

Our GIS team collects residential broadband data twice a year to meet our September 1 and March 1 deadline. At this time, they will remind you to review and update your data. We will also accept data during other times of the year if requested.

How do I include other broadband data on locate.utah.gov?

Other broadband data is collected during our residential data submission and will be automatically loaded to the locate.utah.gov site.

How does the center market locate.utah.gov?

The center frequently promotes locate.utah.gov to key stakeholders in the following ways:

- Trade show booths
- Briefings with local leaders
- Promotional materials to key stakeholders
- Media outreach
- Social media
